Thank you for your March 8, 2010 gift of \$37,640.00 to Doctors Without Borders/Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF). With your support, MSF is responding faster to emergencies and improving the quality and effectiveness of the medical care we provide in more than 60 countries around the world.

Below are a few illustrations of interventions carried out by our medical teams. These accomplishments would not have been possible without the support of our donors. **The War has Ended, but the Suffering Continues:** Violence in the northeast has had a devastating affect on women, children and men in Sri Lanka. While MSF has not been allowed to enter the main conflict area and displaced person camps, our teams have treated 2,000 wounded patients arriving from the zone. During the height of the conflict teams treated blast injuries and gunshot wounds, and they continue to respond to wounds that have not healed correctly. MSF is also providing post-operative care and has set up a 150-bed emergency field hospital adjacent to camps now housing 250,000 displaced people.

**Violence escalates in Somalia:** Drought, conflict, and displacement have continued to plague the people of Somalia throughout 2009. In the first six months of this year, MSF medical teams conducted 376,114 outpatient consultations, provided 22,000 women with prenatal care consultations and 13,312 people were admitted as inpatients to MSF hospitals and health clinics. Over 3,000 surgeries were performed, 1,975 of which were for injuries caused by violence. As one of the few humanitarian organizations remaining in Somalia, our medical services remain critical.

**Devastating earthquake strikes Haiti:** When a devastating earthquake struck Haiti on January 12 our medical teams set up clinics in tents to treat the enormous influx of men, women and children in desperate need of help within the first 24 hours of the disaster. They immediately began administering emergency aid to thousands of people who came with crushed limbs, open fractures, head traumas and burns. By January 20, eight days after the earthquake struck, MSF had treated 5,000 people and performed 900 surgeries.

Every day our field staff use their skills and commitment to bring medical care to those who desperately need it. Thank you again for your generosity.
